Yarns to use: Shimmer, Alpaca Cloud, Shadow, Lindy Chain, Aloft, Curio, Comfy (all weights), CotLin, Stroll, Palette, Paragon, Galileo and Gloss (all weights).

Appropriate items for this collection include: Pullovers, cardigans, tanks, t-shirts, shrugs, skirts, dresses, light accessories (cowls, scarves).

Our intended color theme is shown on the inspiration board. Please keep these colors in mind when putting together your submission. **Please include all relevant information on 1 page**.
