
## 2016 Celtic Journey Collection

**Submission Themes:** Knit Picks is looking for designs for a 6-8 pattern collection to be released in Early Spring 2016, featuring Celtic inspired knits. Knit Picks has chosen yarns for this collection, please see our mood board for the list of yarns, intended colors and inspirational images. For this particular collection, we are looking for knit patterns that are for women

**Brief Description:** Inspired by our bestselling collection Illuminated Lines, we're traveling deeper into Celtic history and style. Textured patterns, traveling cables, colorwork, and traditional silhouettes make these garments, hats, and socks timeless. Colors are greens, soft creams, and woodsy browns in wool and wool blend yarns.

Deadline: May 17.

Compensation/Support: \$200-600 (depending on design) exclusive fee for 12 months. While Knit Picks will knit the samples, KP will also provide yarn support for designer to knit their own version of the pattern. Knit Picks will also photograph all samples & designer will also be able to use photographs for their own promotions. Knit Picks will provide tech edits and the final pattern layout. Patterns will be printed as a single pattern download, eBook and physical book. After one year of the collection being for sale on knitpicks.com, designers may sell the completed pattern in the IDP program, on Ravelry or anywhere else.

**Submission Requirements:** 1 page submission, complete with detailed pattern information, yarn suggested, sketch/swatch of design (swatches do not need to be in suggested yarn, we just want an idea of your design), sizes included, and designer bio/ contact information. Patterns should not be previously published anywhere.

Yarns to use: Palette, Wool of the Andes (all weights) and Swish.

Appropriate submissions for this collection: Pullovers, cardigans, bags, afghans, scarves, hats, mittens with intricate colorwork/knotwork/cables.

**Please include all relevant information on 1 page**. Due to high volume, submissions not in this form may not be accepted. For an example, please click here.

**Send to:** Upload your submission to the <u>Collection Submissions</u> webpage. If you have more than one proposal, each submission will need to uploaded separately. If there are issues with uploading your file, please make sure your pdf is under 5mb. You may also email your pdf to <u>submissions@knitpicks.com</u> but please use the upload area first.

**Other Info:** Patterns will have 12 month exclusivity on knitpicks.com, after that, designers may sell the pattern wherever they wish. Similar to our IDP program, payments will be made electronically. For yarn support, designers must have a US, Canada or Australian address. Submissions will be accepted through May 17 2015; designers will be notified of final decision by May 23, 2015. Finished patterns will be due by July 5, 2015.
